## ORDINANCE NO. 4

## AN ORDINANCE TO PROMOTE PUBLIC SAFETY BY PROHIBITING THE STOPPING AND PARKING OF MOTOR VEHICLES ON STREETS AND HIGHWAYS IN THE TOWN

## THE TOWN BOARD OF NEWPORT, WASHINGTON COUNTY, MINNESOTA, IS:

Section I. No person shall stop, except to receive or discharge passengers, park, or leave unattended, except for the purpose of emergency, any motor vehicle at any time on any road within the limits of the Town.

Section II. As used in this ordinance, the term "motor vehicle" shall include every vehicle which is self-propelled.

Section III. Any person violating the provisions of Section I of this ordinance shall be punished by fine of not more than \$100.00 or by imprisonment for not more than ninety (90) days.

Section IV. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
