Aggregate Industries – MWR, Inc. Material Donation Policy & Request

This document sets forth the protocol for material donations made by Aggregate Industries – MWR, Inc. to eligible property owners who reside near the Larson Quarry and Nelson Sand & Gravel facilities.

The following protocol is hereby defined and established:

- For the Larson and Nelson facilities, an eligible "Property Owner" shall be defined as an individual whose property is located within the limits of Grey Cloud Island Township and the "Lower Island Residents" in Cottage Grove (adjacent landowners located east of the Nelson facility as defined in the Company's Annual Mine Plan). Aggregate Industries shall determine the eligibility of Property Owners requesting material donation(s) and further reserves the right to deny specific donation requests for any reason, in its sole discretion. To avoid the appearance of impropriety elected and government officials, and their immediate relatives, are not eligible to receive donations under this policy.
- Each Property Owner shall be eligible to receive 20 tons of "base" material such as Class 5, 4" Minus, 1½ "Minus or 3/8" Minus, during any given Calendar Year. All other material shall require the approval of the Company's Aggregate General Manager. "Calendar Year" shall mean January 1st through December 31st of any given year.
- There will be <u>a minimum 3-day wait period</u> for all material donation requests. No exceptions shall be made. All requests will be sent via email to the Regional Land & Environment Manager, at <u>patty.bestler@aggregate-us.com</u>. Once requests have been approved, Property Owners requesting material shall take the completed request form to the Larson or Nelson facility OR they can provide the completed form to the third party that will pick up and deliver the material on their behalf. All previous Material Donation Request Forms are "null and void" and will no longer be accepted.
- Ongoing records of all material donations made to Property Owners within each calendar year shall be maintained by the Regional Manager, Environmental and Land Services in Eagan, Minnesota.
- Material is accepted "as is," without any warranty of any kind, and is not guaranteed for specific residential or commercial use. Property Owner relieves and releases Aggregate Industries and its affiliates, of any liability for personal injury, property damage, or any other claims associated with this donation, including, but not limited to, when material is picked up by the Property Owner OR if material is picked up and delivered by a third party.
