ORDINANCE NO. 24

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE OPERATION OF MOTOR VEHICLES UPON THE STREET AND HIGHWAYS OF THE TOWN OF GREY CLOUD, AND PROVIDING FOR PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF.

THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF GREY CLOUD, WASHINGTON COUNTY, MINNESOTA, DOES ORDAIN:

UNNECESSARY ACCELERATION.

NO PERSON SHALL START OR ACCELERATE ANY MOTOR VEHICLE WITH AN UNNECESSARY EXHIBITION OF SPEED ON ANY PUBLIC OR PRIVATE ROADWAY WITHIN THE TOWNSHIP LIMITS OF THE TOWN OF GREY CLOUD, WASHINGTON COUNTY, MINNESOTA. UNREASONABLE SQUEALING OR SCREECHING SOUNDS EMITTED BY THE TIRES; OR THE THROWING OF SAND OR GRAVEL BY THE TIRES OF SAID VEHICLE, OR BOTH, SHALL CONSTITUTE PRIMA FACIE EVIDENCE OF SUCH UNNECESSARY EXHIBITION OF SPEED.

ANY PERSON VIOLATING ANY PROVISION OF THIS ORDINANCE SHALL UPON CONVICTION THEREOF BE GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR.

THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BE IN FULL FORCE AND EFFECT FROM AND AFTER ITS PASSAGE AND PUBLICATION ACCORDING TO LAW.
